FIRST SEMESTER HIGHLIGHTS

In the first semester of the school year, Safe Routes to School staff conducted six safety assemblies, five bike rodeos, four bike repair workshops, six positive presence campaigns at various schools, and distributed No-U Turn banners to 33 schools. Thirty-one schools participated in Walk to School Day on October 10, and eight schools participated in the Walk and Roll Program.
