ORGANIZATIONALLY-SPONSORED FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

- I. The Curriculum and Professional Development Division will develop procedures for organizationally-sponsored foreign exchange students requesting enrollment in the Clark County School District under the J-1 Exchange Visitor Visa Program administered by the U.S. Department of State Bureau of Educational and Cultural Affairs.
 - A. Sponsoring foreign exchange student organizations must be authorized by the U.S. Department of State and recommended by the Council on Standards for International Educational Travel (CSIET) in order to be approved to place students in Clark County School District schools.
 - B. Foreign exchange students are subject to the same District policies, regulations, procedures, rules of conduct, attendance requirements, and academic performance requirements as non-foreign exchange students.
 - C. Foreign exchange students must have sufficient command of the English language to function in a regular classroom. The District will not provide language acquisition or other student services to these students.
 - D. Foreign exchange student organizations and foreign exchange students must comply with all federal, state, and school district regulations, procedures, and rules regarding foreign exchange programs.
 - E. Foreign exchange students will be responsible for all regular school fees and expenses.
 - F. Foreign exchange students may participate in interscholastic athletics provided they meet all rules and regulations regarding eligibility established by the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA).
 - G. Foreign exchange students are awarded a certificate of participation upon the conclusion of time spent in the District. They are not eligible to earn a high school diploma or certificate of attendance.
