



PROTECTING YOUR IPAD

The following suggestions are provided to students who are assigned an iPads thru the Clark County School District. iPads are valuable, and it is your responsibility to ensure they stay with you! Your safety comes first, remember the iPad can be replaced, you can't.

1. Do not display the iPad in public. This includes at school bus stops or walking to and from school.
2. The iPad is for schoolwork first. Your iPad should be treated like a textbook and used for school work and special projects.
3. Do not loan your iPad to anyone. No one should be allowed to "borrow" your IPAD.
4. Do not leave your iPad lying around or out of your possession or view.
5. Keep the iPad in a secure place when it is at your home.
6. Do not show off your iPad, and do not tempt other students who will want to take it from you.

Be aware:

- iPads have built-in tracking devices that work through some apps.
- iPads belong to the Clark County School District. They Do NOT belong to the student or the student's family.
- It is a CRIME to trade, sell or give away the Clark County School District iPad that has been temporarily assigned to you. Depending on the circumstances, a student who fails to return the iPad may be subject to criminal prosecution and/or required to pay the replacement cost of the iPad.
- The iPad may be taken away if there is any misuse or disregard for the protection of the iPad.
