The Clark County School District is committed to fostering a culture that emphasizes integrity and transparency. It is the responsibility of District officers and employees, whether elected or appointed, paid or unpaid, to act with integrity and in full compliance with all applicable rules, regulations, policies, procedures, and state and federal laws.

Fraud is defined as the intentional, false representation or concealment of a material fact for the purpose of inducing another to act upon it to his or her injury. District officers and employees have a responsibility to report unlawful, fraudulent, or unethical activities of which they are aware.
