OUT-OF-DISTRICT CONSULTANTS

The Superintendent shall be responsible for recognizing and anticipating the changing needs of the School District and for developing programs designed to meet those needs. It is recognized that District personnel, however well qualified, may not possess the specific knowledge and technical expertise to enable the best possible program design and implementation. Therefore, the use of out-of-district consultants when their services will make a significant and economically sound contribution to District operations is endorsed.

In order to ensure that the maximum number of District employees benefit from presentations in the most economical manner, out-of-district consultants will be requested to consent to the taping of their presentations. In contracting with out-of-district consultants, preference shall be given to individuals who consent to taping.

The appropriate division head shall determine when a task justifies the engagement of an out-of-district consultant.
