SPECIFICATIONS FOR EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES

- I. The Facilities Division shall develop educational specifications in written form for new facilities to ensure that the facilities being planned are designed to implement current and future educational programs in the best way, and that such facilities have the best potential for accomplishing the goals for which they are designed. Specifications for new educational facilities of the Clark County School District will be consistent with identified needs of the district within fiscal limitations.
 - A. Criteria for development of educational specifications include delineation of:
 - I. Students and employees to be housed.
 - 2. Educational programs to be conducted.
 - 3. Equipment and furnishing requirements.
 - 4. Functional and physical relationships among areas.
 - 5. Pedestrian and vehicular traffic patterns.
 - 6. Special site considerations.
 - 7. All information pertinent to the project that would be of assistance to the assigned architect/engineer.
 - B. A committee of appropriate district staff, including principals, teachers, and out-of-district consultants when deemed advisable, will be established to ensure development of the best possible specifications for each new district facility.
