**Police arrest man suspected of robbing teacher
*Tip from off-duty employee leads to arrest***

Las Vegas – Clark County School District Police have arrested a suspect in the April 13 armed robbery of a teacher at Hickey Elementary School.

The arrest was made possible thanks to the sharp eyes of a CCSD Police Department civilian employee. The off-duty employee was driving in the area of Lake Mead and Mt. Hood at 5:30 p.m. on April 27 when they noticed a vehicle pulled over by a Metro officer for a traffic stop matched the description of the one used in the robbery at the school. The observant employee made contact with the Metro officer and informed them of the possible relation of the vehicle and the robbery. Even though the robbery occurred on a Sunday, school surveillance cameras, which are operational at all times, were able to capture an image of the car to make posters, which were distributed in the community. The employee had seen one of the posters and was able to make the connection based on that information.

Angelo Stackhouse, 38, of Las Vegas was arrested at the scene by Metro on unrelated charges and booked into the Las Vegas City Detention Center. CCSD officers were called in and upon conducting their investigation, earlier today, Stackhouse was booked into the Clark County Detention Center on the following felony charges: Robbery with a Deadly Weapon; Kidnapping with a Deadly Weapon; and Burglary with a Deadly Weapon. ***(Media: a photo of this suspect is available upon request through the Las Vegas Metropolitan Police Department Public Information Office.)***
