CCSD high schools to install college recruiting kiosks

LAS VEGAS – A dozen CCSD high schools soon will install kiosks aimed at providing information to students about higher education opportunities at state-run colleges in Clark County.

Working with the Nevada System of Higher Education, the schools will set up free-standing structures which will be staffed on rotating schedules by representatives from UNLV, CSN and Nevada State College. All three colleges will have equal representation.

According to Michael Englert, Administrative Assistant and Coordinator for the CCSD Instruction Unit, "Many students don't recognize the higher education opportunities that exist locally. These kiosks will make it very convenient for students to learn about local colleges."

Englert says the kiosks are being delivered to the following schools within the next two weeks: Basic HS, Chaparral HS, Las Vegas HS, SECTA, Silverado HS, Cheyenne HS, Cimarron-Memorial HS, Desert Pines HS, ATA, Eldorado HS, Mojave HS and Centennial HS.

College-recruiting kiosks were previously installed at Rancho and Spring Valley High Schools. Their success was a factor in adding kiosks to the additional schools.

Englert emphasized that the kiosks will not interfere with the educational process at any of the existing schools. College recruiters will be on hand only during lunch and after school.

Students will be able to talk with recruiters and obtain literature about each college. At a later date, they may also have the opportunity to register for classes on-site. Englert says all the kiosks will become operational in mid-September.
