Scott Elementary School opening will be delayed ***School will open on a year-round schedule Sept. 15***

Las Vegas – School will begin three weeks later than previously expected for students who will attend Jesse D. Scott Elementary School this fall. The school, located at 5700 N. Bruce St. in North Las Vegas, will open its doors to students for the first time on September 15.

While work on the school was expected to be completed in time for the start of the new school year on August 25, off-site construction related to the new facility will need to be completed before classes begin. The Clark County School District, Pace Contracting and the city of North Las Vegas are working together to complete the project with student safety as the primary focus.

Once the school opens, it will operate on a modified calendar that will be provided to parents at a later date. In order to ensure the school meets the required number of instructional days, Scott Elementary School will utilize the modified schedule for the 2008-09 school year.

CCSD will open four new elementary schools, two new high schools and four replacement schools in August. All of the schools, with the exception of Scott ES, will open on schedule on August 25. Parents of children who are new to the district, or those that have a child who has not previously enrolled in CCSD, are encouraged to register their child in early August.
