Textbooks up for public review

Las Vegas – Textbooks proposed for use in Clark County School District classrooms will be available for public review on Thursday, October 23, and Friday, October 24, as part of Nevada's official textbook selection process.

The textbooks will be on public display from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. both days in the curriculum library at the CCSD Curriculum and Professional Development Center, at 3950 Pecos-McLeod (just north of Flamingo).

The selection of textbooks for use in Nevada public schools is governed by state law. It provides for a district Textbook Committee that includes licensed teachers and administrators, project facilitators, parents and community members for each content area textbook adoption. The committee follows adoption criteria that reflect state content standards, district curriculum objectives, diversity and content organization.

Textbooks recommended for adoption are reviewed and approved by the CCSD Textbook Commission, with final approval by the State Board of Education.

The public review process includes the opportunity to provide written comments about textbooks that are being recommended for adoption.
