Town Hall meeting regarding budget cuts to be streamed online ***Wednesday's meeting at Chaparral High School begins at 6 p.m.***

LAS VEGAS – In order to provide a greater number of residents with insight into the current budget situation facing our community's public school system, the Clark County School District (CCSD) will stream the Town Hall meeting at Chaparral High School on Wednesday, November 19, live to www.ccsd.net. The meeting, which is open to the public, begins at 6 p.m.

CCSD has two Town Hall style meetings scheduled this week in order to inform the public about potential budget cuts and receive feedback on what changes can be made to the district's operating budget.

The first meeting will begin at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, November 18, at Western High School, located at 4601 W. Bonanza Road. The second meeting, which will be streamed to the district's website, will begin at 6 p.m. on Wednesday, November 19, at Chaparral High School, located at 3850 Annie Oakley Drive.

The district has already made \$133 million in cuts but is facing an additional \$120 million shortfall for the next budget cycle, which will require the elimination of some programs, services and staff.
