School district's Northeast Region will host "School Choice Night" ***Event will provide parents with information about open enrollment options***

LAS VEGAS – Parents and students that attend school in the Clark County School District's Northeast Region are invited to attend a public meeting that will provide them with valuable information on the school choice options that are available to them. The meeting will take place on Tuesday, January 27, at Legacy High School, located at 150 W. Deer Springs Way, North Las Vegas, NV 89104.

"School Choice Night" will be divided into two segments. The first segment, which takes place from 6-7 p.m. is designed for parents with children attending an elementary school. The second segment takes place from 7-8 p.m. and is designed for those with children attending middle or high school.

Under the Northeast Region's open enrollment program, parents have the ability to enroll their child at schools other than the one they are specifically zoned to attend. This program provides parents with flexible school options that can suit the skills and needs of their child and family situations.

Applications and information will be available at the meeting. Parents who are not able to attend will be able to obtain the applications and information from their local school or from the Northeast Region offices.
