### **Local architecture firm will donate \$2,500 to two Henderson schools** ***Schools will determine how to use funds to support their students***

**LAS VEGAS** – As state funding for education continues to decline, a number of proactive businesses and individuals are stepping up to support education in southern Nevada. The latest show of support will take place early next month when SH Architecture will make \$2,500 donations to two Clark County School District schools.

On Tuesday, February 3, representatives from SH Architecture will visit Hinman Elementary School, located at 450 Merlayne Drive in Henderson, beginning at 8:20 a.m. to make the check presentation during a staff meeting with teachers.

The representatives will visit McCaw Elementary School, located at 330 Tin Street in Henderson, on Monday, February 9, beginning at 1 p.m. to make the presentation to the staff at that school.

Recognizing that needs vary from school to school, the staff at SH Architecture is making the donations with no restrictions. Each school can choose how they would like to best utilize the funds. This will mark the fourth year the architectural firm has donated funds to CCSD schools.
