McCall Elementary students will “Run for Fun” to find a cure *School principal serves as role model by leading students*

LAS VEGAS – More than 60 students from Quannah McCall Elementary School will be running through the streets of Las Vegas on Saturday, May 2, to support the Race for the Cure.

The event will begin in downtown Las Vegas at 8:45 a.m. The students are part of the Fun Run Club, an after school program started by the school’s principal, Dr. Maria Chairez. By running with the students, Chairez works to instill positive discipline, goal-setting and community service values in her students.

Most of the students who will participate in the event are between the ages of six and 10 representing grades one through five. They will be running one mile in their club T-shirts. The shirts and the race entry fees were provided for students through corporate donations. Parents and the public are invited to attend the event to encourage students, run with them and/or sponsor them with donations.

Funds raised by the students will go to the American Cancer Society’s fight to find a cure for this deadly disease.
