College Fair Plus shows students post-graduation options *32nd annual event takes place at Cashman Center*

Las Vegas – The Clark County School District, in conjunction with district school counselors, will sponsor the 32nd Annual College Fair Plus on Tuesday, October 27 and Wednesday, October 28, from 5:30-8 p.m. at Cashman Center, 850 Las Vegas Blvd.

The College Fair Plus will provide high school students with the opportunity to meet with local and out-of-state representatives from universities, colleges, community colleges, technical schools and the military.

In addition, students and parents can attend workshops to learn effective strategies to search for scholarships and other opportunities for funding college. Other workshops will teach participants about money saving opportunities for college and the options available to students who are interested in pursuing college athletics.

The event is free and open to all high school students and parents. Nearly 7,500 students attended last year's event. Proceeds collected from booth fees, which are paid by fair participants, will be used to award scholarships to local graduating seniors. Last year, more than \$40,000 in scholarship money was awarded.
