EXAMINATIONS AND EQUIVALENT CREDIT

I. Credit by Examination

- A. The credit by examination procedure is an opportunity for the advanced student to progress at the student's own learning rate. Credit is to be awarded on the demonstrated competence through an examination process. Credit by examination is available only to students who have never taken the course for which a test is offered, except for students exclusively enrolled in programs through the Education Services Division. The Education Services Division is responsible for the development of the necessary operations, procedures, and implementation of this exception.
- B. Courses which primarily involve psychomotor skills are to be excluded from the credit by examination procedure.
- C. Students, counselors, and administrators may initiate the process by submitting a completed Credit by Examination form, CCF-847, to the Education Services Division.

II. Equivalent Credit – External/Concurrent Options

- A. Any student enrolled in grades nine through twelve in the Clark County School District may earn high school credit from an approved program outside of the student's comprehensive high school. Students may be allowed to earn a total of six external credits from approved programs.
- B. The Curriculum and Professional Development Division shall establish guidelines which provide direction to high schools and students on granting concurrent credit options.
