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Smarter Balanced Training Tests – New Release

Smarter Balanced recently released a set of Training Tests on January 30, 2014 in order to address the need for teachers and students to be able to familiarize themselves with the features of the Smarter Balanced assessment interface. The new Training Tests will allow the user to preview universal tools, designated supports and accommodations, while sampling new item types that are not currently on the Practice Tests. Although the same item response types are utilized on the Training Tests, there are no performance tasks or scoring guides to accompany the tests.

- Available for grade bands 3-5, 6-8, and high school
- Six to nine items available per content area (ELA and mathematics)

Frequently Asked Questions for the Smarter Balanced Usability, Accessibility, and Accommodations Guidelines
