- Special forms for math (Spanish glossary, Braille, and test-to-speech for grades 4, 5, 6, and 8)
- Special forms for English-language arts (ELA) (Spanish glossary, Braille, and test-to-speech for grades 4, 5, 6, and 8)
- Math performance tasks, including performance tasks for special forms (Spanish glossary, Braille, and test-to-speech)
- Additional items on ELA forms
- Practice Test for use with Internet Explorer 10
