

### 2017 FOSSIL DAY ART CONTEST COMPLETE CONTEST RULES

- Open to all current students in Clark County, kindergarten through 12<sup>th</sup>-grade.
- Designs (hereinafter “designs” or “submissions”) may be submitted by individual students, teams, or classrooms. Unlimited entries are allowed.
- Entries must be original, previously unpublished work, conceptualized and created by student(s), and suitable for printing on a calendar and use in social media posts.
- By entering this contest, each entrant and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of each entrant irrevocably assigns and transfers to Protectors of Tule Springs (POTS) any and all right, title, and interest to the design (and all material embodied therein), including, without limitation, all copyrights and rights of publicity, and POTS shall be the perpetual and exclusive owner of design.
- POTS and/or the Clark County School District (CCSD) may use, distribute, reproduce, modify, adapt, reformat, translate, create compilations and collective works, prepare derivative works based upon, print, record, publish, display, broadcast, transmit, upload, re-post, or otherwise utilize in any manner the original or altered versions of the design or likeness at any time in the future along with the entrant’s name and school, in any and all media or distribution mode now or hereafter known, including without limitation by means of the Internet including tulespringslv.com, protectorsoftulesprings.com, ccsd.net, and other digital networks, and social media, throughout the world, without the need for any further consent and without any compensation.
- Designs must not violate U.S. copyright law and not feature or focus on any material owned or controlled by third parties (including third party copyrighted or trademarked material). For example, do not use any copyrighted images and do not use brands/logos.
- Designs must not be, or contain any content that is or may be perceived as, violent, immoral, defamatory, derogatory, offensive, illegal, obscene, dangerous, unsafe, or similarly inappropriate, or that represents POTS, Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument, or any school in a negative way.
- Each design must be submitted with the Submission Form, including student’s full name, grade level, school, teacher/advisor name, and title of design. A list of all student names involved in the design must be provided on the Submission Form.
- All students involved in the design and the parent(s) or legal guardian(s) of each entrant must sign the Consent/Release Form - Waiver for Entrant in Contest before the design will be accepted into the contest and be eligible to receive a recognition or prize.
- To enter, design(s) should be provided according to the guidelines with required forms as follows:

- Design content will be reviewed and approved prior to acceptance.
- **Submission deadline is September 26, 2017, by 4:00 p.m.**
- A committee of judges established by the Protectors of Tule Springs will review all entries and will select winners. Prizing will depend on the number of entries, and the number of students involved in the winning design(s), and will be announced at the Fossil Day celebration on October 14, 2017, at the Las Vegas Natural History Museum.
- In POTS’ sole discretion, an entrant may not be eligible for recognition or to receive a prize if the submission cannot be sufficiently cleared for legal purposes.
