

T-SHIRT DESIGN CONTEST



A Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument t-shirt design contest has been added this year!

Who: Open to all current Clark County students, grades K-12. Students can compete as individuals, teams, or classrooms.

What: As part of the Mammoth Penny Push campaign, students can create and submit a t-shirt design to be sold by the Protectors of Tule Springs to promote the Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument. All funds raised by the t-shirts will be used to provide educational resources for Clark County students, such as self-contained teaching kits with lesson plans and supplies.

The t-shirt design may incorporate text and/or artwork to promote protecting the resources of the Tule Springs Fossil Beds National Monument. Some thought starters:

- "Protect our Past, Protect Our Park"
- "Tule Springs -- a Hidden Treasure"
- Artwork might feature:
 - Students engaging in the outdoors
 - Fossils
 - Appropriate ice age animals from this region
 - Protected wildlife and plants that currently inhabit Tule Springs
 - Etc.

When: Contest period is March 13-31, 2017. Submission deadline is 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 31, 2017.

How to Enter: To enter, students should create an original design. Designs can be hand-made and/or created with digital tools, as long as the artwork is original. Two forms are required to enter, including one that must be printed, signed by each participating student's parent/guardian, and returned.

- Entries must be original, previously unpublished work, conceptualized and created by a Clark County student(s), and suitable for printing on a standard-sized t-shirt.
- T-shirt designs become the property of Protectors of Tule Springs (POTS); designs may be published, in whole or in part, at any time along with the entrant's name(s) and likeness(es), as t-shirts or other retail items, in POTS publications, in the media, or other channels.
- Entries must not violate U.S. copyright law (for example, do not use copyrighted art or photographs).
- A Submission Form and signed Consent/Release Form Waiver for Entrant in Contest are required.
- A list of all student names involved in the design must be provided on the Submission Form.
- Unlimited entries are allowed.
- Designs should be provided for judging electronically, as a pdf, jpeg, or similar, and emailed, along with required forms, to <u>mammothpennypush@gmail.com</u> or mailed to Protectors of Tule Springs, 517 S. 9th Street, Las Vegas, NV 89101.

How to Win: A committee of judges established by the Protectors of Tule Springs will review all entries and will select winners. Prizing will depend on the number of entries, and the number of students involved in the winning design(s), and will be announced in April 2017.
