

CCSD Bill Drafts

- [SB47](#) Improves workforce conditions for school district employees.
- [SB65](#) Requires background checks & training to run for office as a school board trustee.

Student Learning

- Fully fund the Pupil-Centered Funding Plan based on recommendations by the Commission on School Funding.
- Support efforts that enable acceleration of student learning, which include associated funding.
- Support examining student assessments in more depth.
- Support exploring removing unnecessary tasks for districts, schools, or classrooms, including reporting that is frequently unused.
- Support additional state level support including funding for students with IEPs.

Workforce

- Support pathways to allow union/trades representatives to teach classes specific to their trades in high school, possibly middle school.
- Support pathways to allow professionals to teach classes specific to their profession or skill without requiring a teaching license.

Governance & Transparency

- Support the audit of finances, including ESSER funds, for all education-related entities including the Nevada Department of Education.
- Support building state infrastructure, specifically the Nevada Department of Education.

Mental Health, Health & School Safety

- Support updates to bullying statutes, allowing students who have a substantiated discrimination, cyber-bullying, or bullying incident to be transferred to a different school rather than the victim, and clarify that the statutes are administrative in nature.
- Support updates to sex education statutes for instruction to “opt out” rather than “opt in.”
- Support funding for school districts to implement most critical equipment/systems recommended by safety experts, i.e. single point of entry, perimeter fencing, incident alert systems, dispatch centers/staff, security cameras, intrusion alert systems, and visitor management.
