BEING PART OF A TEAM MEANS WORKING TOGETHER.

Each semester this school year, teachers will work together on an interdisciplinary unit that focuses on a theme. For the first semester, our school theme is conservation. The Grizzlies will focus on recycling, combining that with a community-service activity to clean up litter around the school and neighborhood. Students will learn about renewable and non-renewable resources, collecting data and organizing it for presentation, and write a creative story that portrays the student's version of a world in the future. During the second semester, the school's theme is health and fitness. The Grizzlies will compare the lifestyles of different countries and how that affects the citizens' health and fitness levels, in addition to learning about respiration and heart rate and percentages of fats versus calories in the foods they eat every day.
