

# 2017 Middle School Electronic Photo Contest



**Who:** Contest is open to all Clark County School District middle school students, with one exclusive category for elementary students.

**What:** Entries must be original photos taken by the student. Previously entered photos are not eligible. Accepted photos should be **jpgs**, no smaller than 1500x1200 pixels or 1.2mb (*Size matters because the winner's photos will be enlarged.*) **One entry, per category, per student.** Each photo entry requires a separate email, with the photo file renamed and attached to that email:

Entrants must format their attached photo file this way: **nelsoml2@nv.ccsd.net**

**student name\_photo title\_school.jpg**,  
example: *John\_Doe\_sunflower\_Rogich.jpg*.

Again, in the body of the email, please include this information: photo title, student name, school and teacher/advisor.

**Where:** Students or teachers can email entries to:

Your email and attached photo will serve as your entry form. Remember to use a separate email entry per photo, per category. Middle school students may not enter photos into the Elementary Division.

**When:** Deadline for entries is Wednesday, November 15, 2017.  
Winners will be notified by Tuesday, November 30, 2017.

**Awards Presentation:** Winning students will be recognized in an online photo gallery presentation and receive their prize through school mail.

## THE CATEGORIES

- 1. Me, Myselfie & I** - *This means you must be the photographer. Go beyond the typical self-portrait and be creative.*
- 2. Animals & Insects** - Your pets or critters of any variety.
- 3. Favorite Places** - Inside your world or interesting places you have been.
- 4. School Photo montage** – A collection of school or education related photos.
- 5. Elementary Student Division** - Students must be in elementary school to participate and may enter one photo based on each of the contest categories while competing under the Elementary Division. The photo receiving the most votes will be the winner within this division.

**Prizes:** The photo receiving the most votes within each category will win. The winning photo in each category will be printed to 8"x10" and framed. Also, the student photo selected "Grand Prize" (more votes than any other photo) will receive a \$50 gift card and have his/her winning photo framed.

**You be the final judge!** The best images that illustrate each category will be posted to an online gallery where students, teachers and staff will be allowed to vote once in each of the five categories. The contest coordinator selects the best photos to present for judging in the voting gallery. The Grand Prize award will be given to the photo receiving the most votes.
