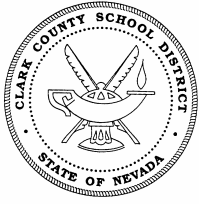

The Superintendent will not cause or allow any circumstances, which endanger the safety, well-being, or academic progress with regard to physical facilities owned or operated by the district.

Further, without limiting the scope of the foregoing by this enumeration, the Superintendent will not fail to:

1. Inform the Board and the Bond Oversight Committee concerning facility/construction issues, including but not limited to:
  - a. Status and rating of bond funds
  - b. Capital improvement plans (including new schools and buildings, renovations and replacement projects)
  - c. Legal, contractual, and administrative issues affecting the building program
  - d. New facility designs
  - e. Issues of equity
  - f. Energy initiatives and alternatives
  - g. Major capital improvement issues
2. Inform the Board and the Oversight Panel concerning financial and legislative issues.
3. Obtain the Board's prior approval to increase construction contract amounts for changes, which exceed Board established parameters of 3% for new construction and 5% for modernization and renovation projects.
4. Review instructional issues when determining school size, design, building usage and appropriate physical environments.
5. Protect student activities, schedules, and calendars from adverse impacts of facility planning issues.
6. Execute all facets of the building program with enduring quality and educational equity on schedule and within the budget.
