COMMITTEE NAME	LIAISON/MEMBER	PURPOSE
American Education Week	2 Liaisons	Trustee role: help plan events and activities during AEW. Time commitment: one meeting per year; promote AEW throughout the district.
Attendance Zone Advisory Commission (AZAC)	1 Liaison	Trustee role: act as a liaison to the community. Time commitment: special Board meetings in February and March*. Purpose of committee: each Board member appoints two members from each district, the appointees bring zoning recommendations to the full Board.
Bond Oversight Committee	1 Liaison	Trustee role: provide BOC with the Board's input. Time commitment: one meeting a month. Purpose of committee: provide input from the Board and identify issues of concern to the BOC. Each Board member appoints committee members.
Clark County Comprehensive Plan Steering Committee	1 Member	Trustee role: equal voting member. Time commitment: one meeting per month. Purpose of committee: recommending body to the Clark County Commission overseeing all aspects of the Comprehensive Plan.
Debt Management Commission	1 Member (who is also appointed to the SNRPC)	Trustee role: represent the Board's need in fulfilling the bond issuance requirements. Time commitment: one meeting a month. Purpose of committee: to secure timely and adequate funding to meet cash flow requirements for construction projects.
NASB Director	1 Member	Trustee role: serve on the Board of Directors. Time commitment: four meetings per year. Purpose of committee: manage affairs of the NASB through ongoing communication with other directors, NASB staff, and attend and participate in meetings of the association.
NASB Legislative Representative	1 Member	To be determined
NIAA Board of Control	1 or more members	Trustee role: serves on the NIAA Board. The board will nominate 5 representatives to the Board of Control of NIAA to represent Clark County School District (Regulation 5135.12) Time commitment: four meetings per year. Purpose of committee: promote, control, supervise, and regulate all interscholastic athletic events and other interscholastic events in the public school.

COMMITTEE NAME	LIAISON/MEMBER	PURPOSE
Oversight Panel for School Facilities-AB 353	1 Liaison	Trustee role: participate in the approval of annual reports to the legislature on the status of fulfilling the need of school construction. Time commitment: as needed. Purpose of committee: secure financial resources for funding school construction.
Parks and Recreation	1 Member	Trustee role: liaison between the Board and citizens of Clark County. Time commitment: seven meetings per year. Purpose of committee: opportunity to link with the community on a variety of issues, and create partnerships.
PBS & APTS	1 Liaison	PBS-Trustee role: KLVX's voting lay representative. Time commitment: one meeting per year; with a 2 year commitment, reviewed yearly. Purpose of committee: Board members from the licensee are invited to the PBS annual meeting and allowed to vote on members of the PBS Board. APTS-Trustee role: lay representative who assists the station in securing individuals willing to lobby for public broadcasting. Time commitment: one meeting per year. Purpose of committee: conduct-lobbying activities before Congress and regulatory agencies to benefit public television.
Public Education Foundation	1 Liaison	Trustee role: serve as ex-officio member of the Foundation's Board of Directors. Time commitment: four meetings per year. Purpose of committee: aid, support, and promote improvement of the CCSD.
School Name Committee	1 Chairperson 2 Members	Trustee role: vote on recommendations presented to the entire Board for approval. Time commitment: one meeting per month. Purpose of committee: review files for each individual nominated and develop an eligibility list.
Sex Education Advisory	1 Liaison	Trustee role: act as a liaison. Time commitment: as needed. Purpose of committee: make recommendations to the Board regarding content and materials that are contained in sex education units.

Represent district needs as necessary.</p> <p>Time commitment: one meeting per month.</p> <p>Purpose of committee: district staff represents the district on the Technical Committee as well as on the Planning Director's Group. The Director's Group advises the Technical Committee, which advises the Coalition. Develops a comprehensive regional policy plan for the balanced economic, social, physical, environmental and fiscal development and orderly growth management of the region.</p>
Student Council Advisory	1 Liaison	<p>Trustee role: serve as a liaison to the Board and attend meetings, answer questions, provide feedback, and suggest topics for discussion.</p> <p>Time commitment: one meeting per month*.</p> <p>Purpose of committee: provide an open forum for students to get information about district policies, procedures, and current events.</p>
The Council of the Great City Schools (Board of Directors)	1 Member	<p>Trustee's role: serve as a voting member of the Board of Directors of the CGCS.</p> <p>Time commitment: two meetings per year (Spring and Fall)</p> <p>Purpose of committee: advocate for the nation's large urban school districts and their children.</p>
