Public Hearing Pilot Program Continues. The Board is extending their public hearing pilot program through September of this year. Members of the public will have the opportunity to address the Board on each agenda item as it comes before the Board, after the Board's discussion, and prior to the Board voting on the item.

Instructional Software - Rosetta Stone. The Board approved to contract with Rosetta Stone to provide licenses, teaching materials, and on-site training that will assist schools by providing extra language support for students.

Quannah McCall Elementary School - Substance Abuse Prevention Program. The Board authorized staff to submit and implement a state-funded subgrant from Goshen Community Development coalition for the Substance Abuse Prevention Program from June 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010.
