Dear District F Constituents, Parents, Staff, Students and Friends:

As of Friday, May 29, 2009, the Governor vetoed the bills that would have established the 2009-2011 state budget and both houses of the legislature have overridden the Governor's veto. I want to thank all of you who contacted your legislators to encourage this override. Your voices were heard and education was spared some of the cuts proposed by the Governor. Thank you.

What does this mean for the upcoming school year and the year after? Our staff are evaluating that as I write this, but for certain, the \$120 million in cuts will remain in place for the 2009-2010 school year. The following year (2010-2011) remains uncertain, as property tax amounts are dropping, but the dollar amount is unknown.

Now that the Legislative Session is over, we will be evaluating the impacts on education and preparing policies, etc. to address the new laws. The education stabilization fund passed both houses and was sent to the Governor, who vetoed it. While the Assembly did override the veto, the Senate did not, so the bill failed. This fund will be a goal for the next legislative session. Thank you to everyone who worked to support education during the session.

As the school year comes to an end for all 9 month schools, I would like to encourage all of you to continue to work with children to support the learning that has gone on throughout the year. Please find ways to augment this learning during the summer months. Also, please keep in mind that year round schools are still in session and school speed zones are still in effect for these schools.

To all of you with children who are graduating, I wish them success in their future endeavors and heartfelt congratulations!

Attached you will find the dates for my F-Troop meetings next year. For those of you unfamiliar with these meetings, I hold a monthly meeting throughout the school year with constituents and community members to share information and to have open dialogue. These meetings are called F-Troop for my trustee district which is District F. They are open to anyone to attend. Please consider coming to one or all!
