The work that I will try to do as a Trustee will stay away from cuts to the classroom and teacher support! I do look forward to hearing of your great suggestions and thoughts.

You may have read about the low math scores that were a part of the semester exams. Dr. Rulfes and Dr. Kohut-Rost are working on a plan to meet with teachers and administrators to ensure that the next semester exams see improvement. The low scores are unacceptable and will need everyone's support to see improvement. The past two years we have focused on reading and writing in the District; but we must continue to work with all students on their math knowledge. Elementary grades are where we begin to introduce math concepts and continue on through middle school and High School. I know I sometimes avoid the math area because of my own inhibitions in that area, but I remember getting tutors and other adults to ensure that my children understood basic concepts so they could move to the next level of math. Know where your children are and what help they may need.
