Thanks to those who attended our April PAC meeting. We had a good discussion on the budget, legislation, and other concerns. Our May PAC meeting will be held **MAY 13TH AT 9:15 A.M. AT THE EAST REGION OFFICE**. Our speaker will come from the Curriculum and Professional Development Department and will address the changes being made to high schools so that even though block scheduling, AVID, and other programs are being put aside because of budget cuts, students will have the opportunity to take classes virtually, or through other means to ensure they have the education they need to complete high school and be prepared for higher education, further study for a career, and/or the work place. I have also asked the district staff to look into the possibility of using some of the education stimulus money to help students with summer school. We will have lots of options and ideas at the May 13th meeting. Please plan on attending or sending a representative from your school. Even though the discussion is on current high school classes, I know that it will be helpful for middle school and elementary parents to hear the discussion and make plans for the future of their students.

The legislature is winding down. Legislators are waiting for the outcome of the Economic Forum on May 1st to assess the current status of our economy. This will drive the real numbers on cuts for CCSD. We will also discuss staying in contact with legislators, and where further cuts may occur. We are still waiting for valid numbers on the stimulus money coming from the federal government and how they will be used. Another concern that I am sensing is the number of students that will return to school in August. If you have an opportunity to register or know of new neighbors that need to register their children, please go to your schools as soon as possible and let them know what children will be attending. This will help with our hiring process.

So much going on! But so many great things. I have heard choirs, bands, student speeches, plays, field trips, so many great activities as school winds down. I also express appreciation to the staff and teachers that have made this another successful year at CCSD. I am sure all of you will be expressing thanks to teachers and nurses during the upcoming appreciation week. There really is **NO WAY** to thank educators for all they do, but I do believe if we talk with our students about thanking teachers through notes or words, it is a great way to teach us all to express gratitude.
