This will allow the legislature to review the economic situation and see if the tax increases are still necessary. I believe that this was a wise plan.

Also, the legislature has worked toward a "stabilization" formula for funding education. This means that when \$\$\$\$ are given to education, they will remain in education budgets, not be funneled to other state needs. Our public, through surveys and input, have said that they support education big time! Let's continue to encourage legislators to support education.

Remember, that I do not have PAC meetings during June, July, and August. I will have my next meeting on September 9<sup>th</sup>; watch for the location! I will send the next PAC letter in August, and we will begin the 2009/2010 school year.

Remember too, that transition years to a new school can be a challenge. Meet your new principal and watch to make sure your student is adjusting to new surroundings.
