Report incidents of bullying and cyberbullying to SafeVoice

It is the procedure of CCSD to encourage students who are subjected to, witness, or overhear incidents of bullying and cyberbullying to report such incidents. Students should report any incident(s) of bullying and cyberbullying to a teacher, counselor, or a school administrator. Students and parents are also encouraged to report knowledge of bullying and cyberbullying via SafeVoice, an anonymous reporting system, which can be accessed 24 hours a day, seven days a week, and 365 days a year. SafeVoice reports can be made through the hotline by calling 1-833-216-SAFE (7233), electronically at safevoicenv.org or through a free mobile app available in the app store for either Android or iPhone. Reports made through the CCSD Say No to Bullying website will be redirected to the SafeVoice site.
