One of the longest running programs within the Clark County School District's School-Community Partnership Office is the Professionals and Youth Building a Commitment (PAYBAC) Program. For more than twenty years, community volunteers have visited middle and alternative high school classrooms as guest speakers.

PAYBAC speakers share with students their own story by incorporating their educational experience, work life, and their struggles and obstacles in obtaining their current career choice. Speakers spend about 45 minutes in a classroom of about 30 students sharing their own stories and messages about the importance of education. Students have the opportunity to hear another voice explaining how education can lead you to your dreams and future.

PAYBAC would not be the program it is today if not for our dedicated volunteers. PAYBAC speakers represent a wide range of Las Vegas' businesses, civic organizations, elected officials, and community volunteers. Speakers bring their diverse backgrounds and educational experiences to students, emphasizing the importance of receiving an education, setting goals, and planning for the future.
