Registration for Clark County School District (CCSD) students for the upcoming 2017-18 school year is available online. **Families with students currently enrolled** can complete registration using the Parent Portal via Infinite Campus [campusportal.ccsd.net](#) There will be an announcement through the Parent Portal linking to the 2017-18 registration page. **Families new to CCSD** may begin their registration process via [register.ccsd.net](#).

Schools will have computers available for parents to use for registration purposes. Parents are urged to register and enroll their students by the first day of class, as state funding methods have changed.

CCSD Provides Free Meals To Children During The Summer Break

New Immunization Requirement

Effective August 14, 2017, the newly required MCV4 (meningococcal meningitis) vaccination is required for all enrolling 7th graders or students new to Nevada schools, 8th grade or above. Students must be fully vaccinated per the Nevada Revised Statute (NRS 392.435) set forth by the Nevada Division of Public and Behavioral Health prior to being enrolled in school. Please contact your child's school with questions or concerns regarding immunization compliance.

Summer Information

With the summer break underway, the Clark County School District (CCSD) is again providing parents with a list of activities and resources to help keep students active and safe. Parents and students can visit ccsd.net/summer, a virtual one-stop shop containing information on topics including summer commencement, summer classes, year-round and Zoom schools, food service programs, Safekey and similar programs, back-to-school fairs, summer camps and even walking and biking trails in southern Nevada. CCSD also reminds families and community members to be cautious while driving near school zones, as year-round schools will still be in session.



Retired CCSD Employees Honored At Reception And Luncheon

School Board members and Superintendent Pat Skorkowsky were among the district officials on hand at Texas Station June 23 for a retirement reception and luncheon to honor CCSD employees who have 25 or more years of service to the district. The event featured vocal performances by Foothill High School student Connor Simpson and Thurman White Middle School student Sebu Shapiro. About 360 CCSD employees retired this year, and their combined experience with the district totaled 10,651 years.

Students With Disabilities

The Case Management Department of the Student Services Division ensures students with disabilities requiring specialized programming are placed in schools that can best meet the child's individual learning needs. Approximately 9,000 students ages 5 to 22 are assigned to one of 871 programs in schools across the District. The Case Management Department reviews the student's Individualized Educational Program (IEP), ensures there is an open seat in the school based on classroom sizes mandated by the Nevada Administrative Code (NAC), and arranges transportation for the student. Most school placements are made within two school days.

Families new to Clark County School District who have a child with special needs are encouraged to contact the Case Management Department. Please bring a copy of the student's Individualized Educational Program (IEP) to the Case Management Office at 4170 McLeod, Las Vegas, 89121, between 7:30 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. IEPs can also be e-mailed to CMResponse@interact.ccsd.net, or can be faxed to (702) 799-1549. Please include a current phone number and address.

Clark County School District families with students placed in self-contained programs who move to a new address during the summer should contact the Case Management office to see if a new school placement is needed, and ensure the bus is routed to the correct location.

The Case Management office is open year-round to provide continuous customer service.
