One Team, One Goal: Making CCSD #1forkids.

The 90-day entry plan outlines initial focus goals including:

- Joining with the Board of School Trustees as a cohesive governance team with a singular agenda focused on improving the achievement of all students
- A focus on rich and rigorous instruction to improve student outcomes
- A focus on human capital, including strengthening collaborative relations with labor unions
- Aligning budget and operation decisions to district priorities
- A focus on organizational capacity and alignment to improve support to schools

Dr. Jara also announced the start of his reorganization plan by hiring two key administrative leaders that he previously worked with during his time at Orange County Public Schools.

The Deputy Superintendent position was already included in the budget, and the Chief of Staff position was created by the consolidation of existing positions.
