**Update from the Finance Department** Members of the Clark County School District (CCSD) budget staff are preparing the first in a series of three scheduled budgets for the upcoming 2019 fiscal year (FY) which starts on July 1, 2018. The budget staff is gathering and analyzing information sources necessary to prepare a tentative budget for submission to the Board of School Trustees in April for consideration and approval. The budget process includes the completion of online strategic workbooks for each school. The workbooks were released to the individual precincts on January 17 and are to be completed by each School Organization Team (SOT) for submission to their School Associate Superintendent (SAS) by February 15.

**Food Service Department** The public is invited to take part in the next in a series of Food Service tours, set for Feb. 8 at 9:30 a.m. Participants will have the opportunity to tour the Central Kitchen and get a first-hand look at the process that feeds millions of CCSD students each week. **The Public Education Foundation** The Public Education Foundation (PEF) was ranked in the top 10 percent among K-12 education foundations in the U.S. in 2017 in an annual study conducted by the Caruthers Institute, a nonpartisan, nonprofit think tank. In addition to ranking 13th in the nation, The PEF is one of only five K-12 education foundations that have ranked in the top 25 for four consecutive years in the study. The Caruthers Institute remarks that its survey, "Stepping Up," is the nation's only annual study and ranking of K-12 education foundations. The study considers eight performance categories in establishing the rankings: annual revenues, revenues per student, total assets, assets per student, investment income, total program expenses, expenses per student, and human capital (volunteers). "As we continue to pursue bold new thinking and creative approaches to improving public education, we are heartened by the latest findings from the Caruthers Institute," said PEF President and CEO Judi Steele.

**Principal for a Day** More than 100 business leaders from the Las Vegas community shadowed 33 CCSD principals on January 17 for the district's annual "Principal for a Day" event. Business leaders began their day at their assigned schools and spent time learning about the successes and challenges in the public education system. They all came together for a luncheon at the Palms Casino Resort where they had an opportunity to hear from Jeremy Aguero, principal analyst with Applied Analysis.
