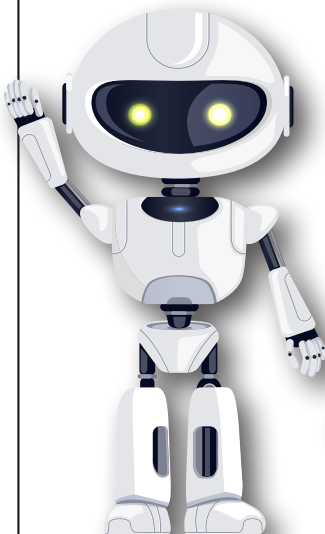

### Yogapalooza with Bari Koral June 4-5

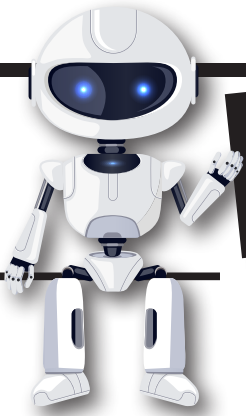
Try yoga with a dancing bear or help create a giant roller coaster of kids. Ages 3-8.

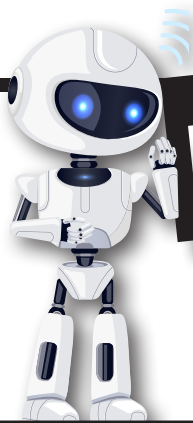
Charming Japanese folktales are combined with traditional musical instruments, magical masks, origami, and mime to create a spellbinding story. Ages 3-17.
