Students whose primary language is other than English cannot effectively participate in general education instruction until they have developed proficiency in listening, speaking, reading and writing English. In accordance with federal guidance, schools must ensure that students with limited English proficiency meaningfully participate in educational programs and services. The Clark County School District's (CCSD) language development approach ensures that English language learners (ELLs) are afforded opportunities to engage in content and language learning that is grade-level appropriate, academically rigorous, and aligned to the Nevada Academic Content Standards and the Nevada English Language Development Standards. CCSD shall implement a consistent and coherent systemic plan focused on English language acquisition, while accelerating academic language development in all content areas thus eliminating gaps in student achievement and high school graduation rates \(\pm\) to assist these English Language Learner ("ELL") students in gaining content and English proficiency, the Clark County School District ("District") shall implement a range of services and programs.
