#### ADMISSION TO ATHLETIC EVENTS

- I. All persons individuals admitted to athletic events must have an admission ticket, adult Season Family Ppass, Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA) pass, Clark County School District (District) CCSD employee ID, or gold card, or student activity card of the home school. Cheerleaders, band members in uniform, and members of marching groups in uniform of from both home and visiting schools are to be admitted free will receive free admission if they are participating and in uniform. Active or retired military personnel with proper identification will pay student receive free admission.
- II. All students (elementary and secondary) without activity cards All elementary and secondary students must pay the student admission fee to attend into high school secondary athletic events. Preschool children Any child under the age of six will not be charged admission.

Effective 2006-07, Season Family Passes \$60.00 (limited to immediate family members only, maximum of 6 persons) will be honored at all regularly scheduled home and away games. Family passes are not honored at school sponsored (self supported) tournaments, playoff games sponsored by the NIAA, non-CCSD schools, and games hosted by private schools.

Addition

A Season Family Pass may be purchased for \$75.00. This will be honored at all regularly scheduled home and away games and is limited to immediate family members only, with a maximum of six individuals. Season Family Passes are not honored at school-sponsored tournaments, playoff games sponsored by the NIAA, or non-District schools.

Addition/ Deletion/ Addition/ Deletion Deletion IV. <u>All aAthletic event</u> ticket revenue, including <u>Season Family Passes</u> <u>season family pass revenue</u>, will be reimbursed to all schools at a rate of <del>fifty (50)</del> percent <del>of the revenue received</del>. The intent of this reimbursement is to share the increased revenue with schools for cocurricular and athletic activities. <del>Seventy (70)</del> percent of the school's revenue is to be used for cocurricular activities.
