Nevada School Law <u>Pursuant to Nevada law</u>, requires that qualified health personnel <u>are required to</u> observe and examine every student regularly enrolled in school, separately and carefully, for symptoms of visual, auditory, scoliosis, or physical impairments. The Student Support Services Division is directed to prepare and distribute to appropriate Clark County School District <u>(District)</u> personnel guidelines conforming to <u>the statutes</u> <u>Nevada School Law</u>.

- A. Any student shall be exempt from physical examination provided the student's parent/guardian or guardian files with the school principal a written statement objecting to the examination.
- B. This written statement of objection to physical examination shall <u>Bb</u>ecome a permanent attachment to the student's cumulative health <u>inventory</u> <u>record</u>.

III. Immunization of Students

- A. Nevada School Law law requires that parents/guardians of all students enrolled in Nevada Schools shall submit evidence that the student is immunized against diphtheria, pertussis (whooping cough), tetanus, poliomyelitis (polio), rubella (German measles), reubola rubeola, and other such diseases as the local Board of Haealth or the State Board of Health may determine, unless there is a medical or religious exemption in accordance with Nevada law.
- B. Local health officers are required to adopt regulations for the enforcement of immunizations, including establishment of time limits and schedules for the immunization of students at various grade levels, after consultation with the Bboards of Ttrustees of school districts in accordance with Nevada law.
- C. The Student Support Services Division is directed to prepare and distribute to appropriate District personnel guidelines for the regulation and enforcement of the immunization requirements conforming to the standards developed by the Clark County Health Department Southern Nevada Health District.
