PRACTICE EVACUATION OF SCHOOL BUSES

- I. Students transported on school buses shall practice evacuation of a school bus as indicated below.
 - A. Regular School Bus Route

A regular scheduled school bus route is one that transports students to and from school on a regular basis.

Students transported on a regular school bus route shall receive instruction in and practice an evacuation at least twice each school year.

B. Field Trip

A field trip is a District-approved trip, associated with an academic or vocational area of learning, that extends the classroom into the community for an instructional purpose.

Students transported on a field trip shall receive instruction in and practice an evacuation at the beginning of each trip.

C. Extracurricular Activity Trip

An extracurricular activity trip is a District-approved trip that provides transportation to and from any athletic activity or any other activity not directly related to an instructional program.

Students transported on an extracurricular activity trip shall receive instruction in and practice an evacuation twice during each activity season.

- II. The Director of Transportation shall:
 - A. Establish uniform procedures for the instruction of each practice evacuation of school buses.
