

STUDENT DISMISSAL (VOLUNTARY AND INVOLUNTARY)

- I. Expulsion is the termination of enrollment in the Clark county School District by the Board of School Trustees as the result of behavior so serious that future attendance in the regular schools of the district is not contemplated.
- II. Exclusion is the temporary termination of enrollment in district schools because of medical reason or other conditions such that continued enrollment would be detrimental to the student, to other students, or to the educational program.
- III. Exemption is the release from the legal obligation to attend school by the student's voluntary withdrawal before completion of the secondary program.
- IV. The Division of Alternative Education is responsible for developing and implementing procedures for student dismissal and specifying these procedures in the Student Regulations and Procedures Manual in accordance with Board policy and Nevada statutes.
