STUDENT DISCIPLINE AND COOPERATION WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES

- I. The Clark County School District will cooperate with other agencies whose objectives are to promote the mental and physical well-being of youth.
- II. As permitted by law, appropriate information shall be provided to law enforcement agencies and cooperation given in apprehending those who may have violated the law.
- III. The principal of each school shall establish a plan to provide for the progressive discipline of students and on-site review of disciplinary decisions in accordance with Board of School Trustees' policies, regulations, Nevada Revised Statutes, and other applicable law.
