HOMEWORK

- I. The Clark County School District acknowledges the educational validity of homework as an extension of the instructional program of the schools in kindergarten through grade twelve. "Homework" shall refer to those assignments to be prepared by the student outside of the school or independently outside of the classroom.
- II. Homework should always serve a learning purpose. The number, frequency, and degree of difficulty of homework assignments should be assigned based on the academic ability of the student.
- III. Homework should take into account school activities that make a claim on the student's time.
- IV. The Clark County School District does not require homework for each subject and content area.
