

ASC – ASSOCIATION LEAVE

ELIGIBILITY:

1. An Association Leave of Absence is only available to licensed or support professional employees.
2. An employee must be post-probationary in their current bargaining unit.
3. A licensed employee must have completed two full years of employment in the employee's current bargaining unit, unless elected for president or vice president.
4. An Association Leave of Absence may be granted to a licensed employee to:
 - a. Serve in an appointed office of the Association or another Association with which it is affiliated.
 - b. Perform Association business as the president or the vice president of the Association.
5. An Association Leave of Absence may be granted to a support professional employee to perform Association business as the president of the Association.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION:

1. Must submit a letter from the Association verifying the employee's election and term.
