Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE)/ Pre-Kindergarten (Pre-K) Immunization Requirements 2025–2026 School Year

Below are the immunizations, per Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 392.435, which are required before entering an ECSE/Pre-K Program. Once enrolled, a child who turns 4 years of age has 30 days to complete the required immunizations pursuant to NRS 392.435 and 394.192.

4 DTP or DTaP (lab titer NOT acceptable) (minimum age: 6 weeks)	 5 DTP or DTaP (lab titer NOT acceptable) 5th dose not needed if 4th dose given on or after the 4th birthday and at least 6 months after the previous dose.
2 HEP A (lab titer acceptable)	2 HEP A (lab titer acceptable)
(minimum age: 12 months)	 2nd dose must be given at least 6 months after the 1st dose.
3 HEP B (lab titer acceptable) (minimum age: Birth)	 3 HEP B (lab titer acceptable) 1st and 2nd dose must be separated by 4 weeks. 2nd and 3rd dose must be separated by at least 8 weeks. 3rd dose at least 16 weeks after the 1st dose. (Minimum age for final dose- 3rd or 4th dose is 24 weeks of age.)
1 MMR (lab titer acceptable)	2 MMR (lab titers acceptable)
(minimum age: 12 months)	Compliant if 2 doses at least 4 weeks apart.
3 Polio (lab titer NOT acceptable)	3-4 Polio (lab titer NOT acceptable)
(minimum age: 6 weeks)	 1st, 2nd dose, and 3rd dose must be at least 4 weeks apart. Final dose (3rd or 4th dose) at least 6 months after previous dose and on or after 4th birthday. 4th dose not needed if 3rd dose is at least 6 months from the previous dose and on or after 4th birthday.
1 Varicella (lab titer acceptable) (minimum age: 12 months)	 2 Varicella 1st and 2nd dose should be separated by 3 months. Compliant if at least 4 weeks apart.
