## ADVERTISEMENT FOR BIDS

Pursuant NRS 338.1385, bids will be received at the Clark County School Contract, Procurement and Compliance, 1180 Military Tribute Place, Henderson, NV 89074 until **Tuesday, October 27, 2020, at 9:00 am,** through the E-Builder bidding module and read aloud publicly for the furnishing of all labor and materials to perform the Work in conjunction with the construction of:

## Laughlin High School, Replace Roof Covering MPID# 0014432, PWP# CL-2020-436

The Work consists of: Adding a roof overlay to 100% of the existing roof system. The existing roof system consists of modified bitumen roofing, over a 1/2" layer of fibrous insulation board, over two (2) layers of polyisocyanurate insulation, over the structural deck or concrete. The new roof overlay that will be added on top of the existing roof system, will consist of an 80 mil PVC roof membrane, over 1/2" cover board, over 1-1/2" polyisocyanurate insulation. This project also includes the replacement of all roofing accessories such as coping caps, termination bars, pipe supports, roof walk pads, expansion joints, roof drain clamps and domes, as well as reflashing and resealing at and around all equipment, pipes, penetrations, etc. All existing equipment is to remain unless otherwise noted. Additionally, the following architectural items are included in this project scope:

- 1. Adding guardrails or anchor cable systems at equipment within 10'-0" of a parapet wall that has a height lower than 42", or where it is considered a fall hazard.
- 2. Adding roof to roof access ladders.
- 3. Sealant at CMU control joints will be etched out and replaced with new backer rod and sealant.
- 4. Repair open cracks in CMU with backer rod and sealant.
- 5. All dents and cracks in the stucco screen walls on buildings A and B will be patched and repaired.
- 6. Conduit that sits on top of the parapet walls or roof will be rerouted to sit on roof support blocks.
- 7. Permanently securing two (2) antennas to the roof that are currently being supported by CMU blocks.
- 8. Remove and replace sealant around Kalwall windows.
- 9. Miscellaneous priming and painting of various metals (flashings, gas line, new roof ladders, etc.).

Prequalified Bidders shall have a Nevada Contractor's License with the Classification of C15, C15-A.

The construction estimate for the project is: \$2,355,000.00.
