**SUBJECT:** Bullying/Cyberbullying Annual Summary Report

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Quarterly bullying/cyberbullying data were available in Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 392.462 reports provided to the Board of School Trustees during the 2020-2021 school year.

Per District Policy 5137, the Education Services Division has reviewed the data contained in the following categories:

- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Disability - 6 incidents
- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Gender Identification/Sexual Orientation - 32 incidents
- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Race - 28 incidents
- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Religion - 2 incidents
- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Sexual Harassment - 54 incidents
- Bullying/Cyberbullying - Stalking - 7 incidents

Trends emerged from the data reinforcing the requirement that each school contacts the Clark County School District Office of Diversity and Affirmative Action when one of these incidents occurs to ensure compliance with *Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964*, NRS 651.070 *Equal Enjoyment of Place of Public Accommodation*, and *Title IX of the Education Amendments Act of 1972*. This information will be provided to school leaders during the back-to-school professional learning sessions in preparation for the 2021-2022 school year and is explicitly outlined in the *Pre-Kindergarten-12 Student Code of Conduct*.
