Sex Education Advisory Committee
Selection Process

Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) [389.036](#) mandates that a Sex Education Advisory Committee (SEAC) to the Board of School Trustees for all school districts be established. Clark County School District [Regulation 6123](#) and [Policy 6123](#), Instruction on the Human Immunodeficiency Virus, Human Reproductive System, Related Communicable Diseases, and Sexual Responsibility, state that the Board of School Trustees shall appoint an advisory committee consisting of the following representation for a two-year term:

1. Five parents/guardians of children who attend schools in the Clark County School District (District).
2. Four representatives, one from each of four of the following professions or occupations:
 - a. Medicine or nursing,
 - b. Counseling,
 - c. Religion,
 - d. Pupils who attend school in the District, or
 - e. Teaching.
3. Two students will be appointed as non-voting members to serve as a resource to the committee.

SEAC is looking to fill the following vacancies: counseling, religion, one parent/guardian, and one student.
