**INTRODUCTIONS**

Tracy Murphy introduced the AZAC members and Demographics, Zoning, and GIS staff that were present. She provided an overview of the purpose of the Public Input Meeting and explained that the Commission would review the public's comments and make recommendations at their regular meeting on January 16, 2024. The recommendations would then be forwarded to the Superintendent and Board of School Trustees for their meeting in late February.

### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

Tracy Murphy stated the proposal for review is for Focus Area M1 which will adjust the attendance boundaries for B. Mahlon Brown Academy of International Studies, Lyal Burkholder and Jack and Terry Mannion Middle Schools, and Barbara and Hank Greenspun Junior High School. She said the primary reason for this evaluation is due to a \$15 million grant that the Clark County School District received from the Magnet Schools Assistance Program to implement new Environmental Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics Magnet Programs at Carroll M. Johnston and Lyal Burkholder Middle Schools beginning the 2024–2025 school year. This results in the need to dissolve the current Burkholder Middle School attendance zone. Ms. Murphy stated that, with the zoning recommendation, AZAC may choose to recommend grandfathering of students currently enrolled in Grades 6 and 7 within the reassigned areas; therefore, only incoming Grade 6 students and newly enrolled students to the area would be reassigned each year.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jessica Almendarez, former teacher at Burkholder Middle School, stated that she is against the rezoning as the school was under enrollment.

### **STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

Tracy Murphy stated the proposal for review is for Focus Area H1 which will adjust the existing attendance boundaries of Basic Academy of International Studies and Chaparral High School. Basic High School students residing north of Russell Road and west of the Precinct Boundary must travel southeast, approximately seven miles to school. Chaparral High School is less than two miles from these neighborhoods, potentially providing a safer route to school. Ms. Murphy said that Basic High School is at 118.39 percent of program capacity and Chaparral High School is at 88.97 percent. Reassigning this area to Chaparral High School would provide enrollment relief to Basic High School. Ms. Murphy stated that, with the zoning recommendation, AZAC may choose to recommend grandfathering of students currently enrolled in Grades 9, 10, and 11 within the reassigned areas; therefore, only incoming Grade 9 students and newly enrolled students to the area would be reassigned each year.

### **PUBLIC COMMENT**

Jessica Almendarez, parent, Basic High School, stated that she is against the rezoning as they are over capacity.
