STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Rick Baldwin reviewed proposals 1 and 2.

Rick Baldwin called for public comment on the elementary school proposals.

One parent from Frias Elementary School spoke in support of Proposal 1, as it moves fewer students.

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

Rick Baldwin reviewed the two proposals to adjust the attendance zone boundaries of Canarelli Middle School, Faiss Middle School, Fertitta Middle School, Schofield Middle School, Tarkanian Middle School, Greenspun Junior High School, and Lawrence Junior High School. Mr. Baldwin pointed out that there were corrections to the proposals, which were distributed to those who did not have a copy. Mr. Baldwin explained phasing.

Rick Baldwin called for public comment on the secondary proposals.

One parent from Faiss Middle School spoke in support Proposal 2 or no change.

A few parents from Fertitta Middle School and Christensen Elementary School expressed a desire for their students to remain at Fertitta Middle School and to promote from Christensen Elementary School to Fertitta. Some will have students in two middle schools. High school feeder alignment is also a concern.

One parent from Tarkanian Middle School wants her second child to attend Tarkanian Middle School as her first did.

One parent from Canarelli Middle School prefers Proposal 2, but doesn't like the prospect of students in two middle schools.
